

Cross-Driven Ministry
Galatians 6:14-18

By God's grace, we are free to engage in ministry that proclaims the cross.

Free from enslavement to the world's desire and demands (v. 14).

¹⁴ But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Free to pursue a ministry that God finds worthy of commendation (v. 15).

¹⁵ For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation.

Free to call others to find peace and mercy in Jesus Christ alone (v. 16).

¹⁶ And as for all who walk by this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God.

Free to suffer for Christ (v. 17).

¹⁷ From now on let no one cause me trouble, for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus.

Free to rejoice in the grace of Jesus Christ (v. 18).

¹⁸ The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers. Amen.
